Children's Bureau provides a variety of services to children and families in Los Angeles, Orange and San Bernardino Counties.

All services focus on the treatment and prevention of child abuse and neglect and helping families with young children living in at-risk environments.

*Children's Bureau identifies parent education and community support systems as two vital strategies in the prevention of child abuse and initiated a focus such that 50% of our program efforts are with newborns to three-year-olds. Along with a dynamic parent education program called [NuParent](#) Children's Bureau has established [Family Resource Centers \(FRCs\)](#) in five of its 13 community sites. The agency has been awarded a state grant to form the [Family Resource Center Technical Training and Support Team](#) which acts as a training model for other organizations wishing to open their own FRC.*
