Fiscal Year 2009/2010

- **A Proud History of Service to Children and Families**
 - Founded in 1904
 - Vital partner in starting the Community Chest, now the United Way
 - Key role in establishing the USC School of Social Work
 - Developed the Family Assessment Form, a nationally used evaluation tool to assess family functioning and treatment

- **Children and Families Reached**
 - More than 3,500 children and parents helped each year
 - Serving children birth through age 18, with special emphasis on children birth to five

- **Client Profile**
 - 95% of families live at or below the poverty level
 - 82% Latino
 - 5% Caucasian
 - 8% African American
 - 5% Asian Pacific and other ethnic groups

- **Financial Overview**

Los Angeles:

 - \$13.3 million annual operating budget
 - 88% of budget goes directly to programs
 - 9% of budget is administration and community relations
 - 3% of budget is fundraising
